NARRATIVE:

PRIMARY

CASE TITLE: Malicious Mischief

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

On 07 12 18 at 1103 I was dispatched follow up on a malicious mischief report involving the Glenhaven Lakes Association. I then spoke to the Association Manager Becky DODD who told me about the incident.

Becky told me she first reported the incident on 07 07 18 (CAD showed 070718 at 1829 under case 18A25137). Becky told me she now had an estimate of the damage that occurred and some possible suspect information. A check showed no report was written under the original incident and Becky was given the follow up case number for the report.

Becky told me the Glenhaven Lakes Association keeps their tractor parked in the 600 block of Rainbow drive where their maintenance materials (sand, gravel etc) are stored. On 07 07 18 they discovered that the tractor had been vandalized in multiple ways. Rocks were left in the hydraulic knuckle joints of the tractor, sand and gravel were dumped inside the cab and the tractor's fire extinguisher was discharged inside the cab of the machine.

Becky said it took Glenhaven Lakes employees a whole day to clean up the mess and remove the rocks from the tractor. At the time they were in the middle of a culvert replacement project and the delay required to clean up the tractor so it could be used caused an expensive delay. Becky's estimate was that it took four employees eight hours to reverse the damage and make the tractor operable (estimated at \$1000 time and labor).

Becky recently received a tip from one of the local families that several local juveniles were involved in the vandalism. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] and Apollo SCOTT were named by Clinton MCSTOTT's son as suspects. According to Becky both [REDACTED] and Apollo have been bragging that they were involved in vandalizing the tractor along with several other juveniles.

Contact needs to be made with the McStott family to verify all the possible suspects. Becky will forward pictures of the vandalism for inclusion with the report.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

On 07 20 18 at about 1100 hours I responded to the Glenhaven area to conduct follow up interviews with malicious mischief suspects [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Apollo SCOTT and [REDACTED] [REDACTED]

I first attempted to meet with Apollo Scott and was told he was doing community service at the Glenhaven Office. I then met with [REDACTED] at his residence, [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] agreed to talk to me about the vandalism to the tractor and gave me a signed statement describing the incident. [REDACTED] admitted that several weeks ago he, Apollo Scott and [REDACTED] all found a tractor at the Glenhaven gravel pit. [REDACTED] said they put sand in the tractor, disconnected some running lights, put something in the exhaust pipe and put a fire extinguisher in the engine compartment.

After speaking with [REDACTED] I responded to the Glenhaven Association office where I saw Apollo Scott doing yard work outside in the parking lot. Apollo said he would talk to me and told me the manager Rebekka Doda was inside. Rebekka told me the Association was not pressing vandalism charges against the three boys at this time. She told me an agreement had been worked out with Apollo to do community service for the Association and that they would try to work this out with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] as well.

Rebekka then told me she did not know if [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] would be cooperative and I told her to contact me if things could not be worked out. After I talked to Rebekka, I spoke with Apollo who told me the same thing [REDACTED] had in his statement. The only three people involved in the vandalism were himself [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

After my contacts with Rebekka and Apollo I responded to the area on Glenhaven Drive where [REDACTED] was supposed to be staying but was unable to locate his residence. At this time I do not have full information on [REDACTED] or his address. Rebekka gave me a general location which was incorrect.

Since the Glenhaven Association is not pursuing charges this report should be filed for information only.
